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Introduction to Novlingue

Based on my previous project called *Reformed Novial*, I have introduced several changes in the language, which I thought have improved it. These changes are:

- I took out from the alphabet the letters CH, SH, and Z. Now they are C, X, and S; so that there is one letter, one sound correspondence.
- Y is only used in the preposition Y (and).
- The passive is just BLI + infinitive.
- The language is more analytical than Reformed Novial.
- The participles have been changed.

This language has been influenced by Glosa and Mini, two isolating conlangs.

Nouns

Nouns end in **-e**. They never change.

If you want to specify whether it is a man or a woman, you can add **-he¹** or **-fe²**.

- **doktore** – doctor (male or female)
- **doktore-he** – male doctor
- **doktore-fe** – female doctor

For the plural, we use the plural article.

- **i doktore** – (the) doctors

The accusative is identical to the nominative, and it is never marked. The genitive is formed with the preposition **de³**.

- **E hause de e doktore** or **i hause de i doktore**
 - The doctor's house or the doctors' houses.

Adjectives

All adjectives end in **-i**, but this may be dropped if it is easy enough to pronounce and no confusion will be caused.

Adjectives do not agree with the noun.

- **u bon(i) puere**— a good boy or a good girl
- **i bon(i) puere** – good children (boys and/or girls)
- **u bon(i) puere-he**— a good boy
- **u bon(i) puere-fe**— a good girl
- **i bon(i)** - the good ones
- **u bon(i)** – a good one

They can be written before or after the noun, although the preferred position is before it.

Degrees of adjectives

Comparative adjectives are formed by placing various particles (*plu*, *tam*, and *min*) in front of the adjective receiving the comparison and *kam* afterwards. Likewise, the superlative particles (*li maxim* and *li minim*) precede the adjective. The adjective does not receive an inflection to its ending.

- *I blanki es plu bel kam i redi.*
- *I blanki es tam bel kam i redi.*
- *I blanki es min bel kam i redi.*

Se is the reflexive pronoun.

Possessive

We add **-n** to the personal pronouns to form the possessive.

- **men** – my, mine
- **nin** – our, ours
- **ten** – your, yours
- **vin** – your, yours (more than one person)
- **len** – his, her, hers its
- **lin** – their, theirs

Demonstrative

- Ti and ta > this and that
- ti-lok and ta-lok > here and there
- I-ti and – i-ta > these and those

Examples:

⁴ If it is strictly necessary to make a distinction between he and she, *he* and *fe* can be used, but only when there is a need for it. This usually happens when they appear on the same sentence.

- Ti es men kate > This is my cat
- Ti kate es men > This cat is mine
- Ta hause es ten > That house is yours.
- Ta es vin hause > That is your house.
- I-ta hause es lin > Those houses are theirs.

Verbs

All infinitives end in -a.

All persons are the same: me ama, te ama, vi ama, etc.

The negative is formed with **no** (*not*), which precedes the verb.

ni no sava le – we don't know it

Note: *nun* indicates it is a continuous tense while *ha* indicates it is a perfect one.

Passive voice

In this language, there is no distinction between passive of becoming or passive of being⁵.

There is only one way of forming the passive: bli + infinitive

Auxiliary verbs

There are several auxiliary verbs that are monosyllabic:

dev (*should*), did, es, ha⁶, had, let, mej (*may*), mus (*must*), pov (*can*), va, vol (*want*), vud (*would*).

Some examples on how to use the participles:

- Te omni-tem vada ne-kora omni-lok
 - *You always go running everywhere*
- Novilingue es u de-konstruktta lingue.
 - *Novilingue is a constructed language.*

Adverbs

An adjective is converted to a corresponding adverb by adding **-m** after the **-i** ending of the adjective. Ex: boni > bonim.

Comparative and superlative adverbs are formed in the same manner as comparative and superlative adjectives: by placing a specific particle before the adverb receiving the comparison.

There are some “proper adverbs”, which do not use -im.

We can group the adverbs according to their sense and thus we have adverbs of time, manner, degree, place, quantity, doubt, affirmation, and negation.

The *adverbs of manner* answer the question **Ki-man?**, for instance: ti-man, kelki-man, omni-man, nuli-man

The *adverbs of quantity* answer the question **Ki-sum?**, for instance: ti-sum, kelki-sum, omni-sum, nuli-sum.

The *adverbs of place* answer the question **Ki-lok?**, for instance: ti-lok, kelki-lok, omni-lok, nuli-lok

The *adverbs of time* answer the question **Ki-tem?**, for instance: ti-tem, kelki-tem, omni-tem, nuli-tem

The *adverbs of affirmation, negation or doubt* are: jes, no, forsan.

Questions

Yes/no questions

For yes/no questions, we add the word **ob** at the beginning of the sentence:

- **Ob vi parla Novlingue?** - Do you speak Novlingue?
- **Ob vi konosa lu?** – Do you know them?

Question words

We add a question word at the beginning of the sentence and this doesn't change the word order (as it occurs in English).

- **Ku te vola?** – What do you want?
- **Ki-tem te va vena?** - When will you come?

Answering questions

Positive answer is **yes** and negative answer is **no**.

- **Ob** te drinka kafe?
 - **Yes**, me drinka kafe.
 - **No**, me no drinka kafe.
